We have been focusing on providing lots of sensory experiences such as exploring the water and the sand. We created a waterfall using tubes and we have been digging and building sand castles in our sandpit. These wetter days have been bringing out lots of mini beasts for us to look at as well.

Our main topics have included Fairyland, The Gingerbread Man, Dear Zoo and much more. We really enjoyed dressing up as fairies together. We have done lots of building in our constructions area. We have been building lots of different habitats too—our favorite was the mini beast den.

We have made some brilliant pictures over the past months and we have been updating some of our big

displays in the room. We created a huge elephant for the Dear Zoo topic and also a giant gingerbread man.

Our next topics will include transport and vehicle themes. We look forward to creating many fantastic activities and learning around this theme.



Little Divers

In the world of Little Divers, we have been having a lovely time exploring many fascinating topics.

Our big topics have included Fairyland and Summer. We had lots of fun coming up with interesting ways to explore these topics. We made some beautiful Fairy pictures to show on our topic of the month board.

We looked at airports and holidays when learning about summer. We love the outdoors and so we took a lot of our activities outside.

We have been developing many key skills engaging in group times. We have been singing with Ashley and it has been really lovely to see how children's attention and enthusiasm for learning is improving

and growing.

Over the next couple of months our big theme will be animals. We're going to be looking at farm animals, under the sea animals, jungle animals and lastly dinosaurs!

Little Rangers



Well we have had a very emotional and busy few weeks. The graduation was such a beautiful success. It was so amazing to see everyone coming together for the special day. It was wonderful to hear all the songs the children had been practicing too. All the staff worked so hard to make the event run smoothly and to make sure everyone had a great time.

It cannot be understated just how much we will miss all of those who are leaving us in only a few weeks—some of which have already had their last day. We have loved teaching you and it's been a pleasure to watch you all grow in a number of different ways! Our aim is to support the children to be as best prepared for school as possible but it's still hard for us to say goodbye.

Over the last few months, we have been learning lots about countries around the world focusing on India, Australia, Spain and Italy.

We have been exploring the culture of India and learning about Henna and Diwali.

More recently, we have been focusing on Sealife and the ocean. Children have enjoyed discussing their own experiences of going to the beach as well as learning about different sea creatures. For the final week learning about the ocean, we are learning about pollution in the sea and about how we can limit this.

To encourage independence, we have been using cups more to help us develop our gross motor skills. This is going really well with children enjoying being responsible at meal times, trying hard not to spill their drinks.

Our next topic, starting in September is 'All About Me'. During this topic, we will discuss our different families, our own appearance, our interests and our pets too!



General

Spare Clothes

All children require a spare set of clothes in their bags. Even if your child is out of nappies, they may get wet in water play or muddy in the mud kitchen so please ensure you have spares in their bags for them. (This includes pants and socks please).

Please also label all items of clothing, to ensure that we can find any misplaced items and reunite you with them.

Registered Days

We are very happy to say that in most rooms, we are working at ca-

capacity. We would like to remind you that whatever days and sessions your child is currently signed up for, is guaranteed for you throughout their nursery time. However, we cannot guarantee that you will be able to add additional hours later down the line e.g. when your funding begins for your child. Therefore it's imperative that this is considered well in advance.

Additional Days

If you require any extra days to your child's registered days, please let us know in advance so that we can assess our registers and see if we can accommodate your request.

Please be advised that we cannot accommodate swaps due to most rooms being at capacity, unless otherwise authorised by Directors in extenuating circumstances.

We would like to remind parents that if they require additional days or have any other important requests, please do not use tapestry to let us know. You need to email us with your request so we can see it. Tapestry has so many updates added regularly that is very easy to miss a message from a parent. Hopefully by emailing directly it will make things easier for us all. Thank you.

General availability

We are extremely fortunate and happy to say that Little Feet nursery now only has limited places in Nursery across all of our rooms. Please let us know if you'd like to put any new siblings on our waiting lists as we are already almost at capacity from April 2024 in our Little Climbers room. Additionally, if you have any friends or family who are interested in putting their child into Little Feet, please encourage them to get in contact as soon as possible, to avoid disappointment.

Invoices

Automatic reminders will be sent out 2 days before invoices are due and again when invoices are overdue. If you receive a reminder but have already paid, please disregard the email. Our accounting software can take up to about 48 hours to pull through bank transactions.

Our reasoning for implementing automatic reminders, is that unpaid invoices result in us spending considerable amounts of time contacting parents, which means we spend less time in the classroom supporting your children. In order to reduce the amount of late payments, we will be enforcing late payment charges of £15 if payments are overdue.

Uniform

If you would like to order any uniform for your child, just ask in your room or email Vicky and Sophie. We can either email you an order form, or you can complete your order with us directly. We would like to encourage all the pre-school to wear the uniform as it will help them to take another steppingstone in preparing them for their transition to school. Please note payment by BACS is preferred, or we can add the amount onto your monthly invoice should that be preferable.

NEG funding

If your child turns 3 between 1st September 2023 and 31st December 2023 then funding will commence in January 2024. Ahead of this time, your child will be sent home with a funding form for you to complete and return to us. Please be advised that when funding commences for your child, a £6 consumables fee is chargeable per funded day they attend nursery. If you require any more information regarding any of the above, please do not hesitate to speak to either Vicky or Sophie and we will be glad to help.

Early drop off and late pick up

Following the recent reminders that we have sent out, we have had only very few cases of children being dropped off before their registered start time and/or being picked up after their registered finish time. We thank you for this as it ensures that we are being compliant in terms of governmental ratios. Please be advised that if your child is registered to start their session at 8am, and you try to drop them off at 7.50, you will be asked to wait outside until 8am—this may be due to additional staff members starting their shift at 8am for example. We have introduced a fee of £1 per minute for picking children up late/dropping them off early.

If due to unforeseen circumstances, you find yourself running late, please do let us know so that we can make suitable arrangements.
